## **THORNTON-LE-MOORS** **EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION CHARITY**

### **SCOPE OF THE CHARITY**

**PROVIDE GRANTS TO INDIVIDUALS UNDER 25 YEARS OF AGE WHO ARE UNDERGOING FULL TIME EDUCATION; TO YOUTH ORGANISATIONS AND TO SCHOOLS WHO ARE ALL ABIDING WITHIN THE ANCIENT PARISH OF THORNTON-LE-MOORS.**

An extract from the Thornton-le-Moors Educational Foundation's Constitution regarding the application of income of the charity.

### **Application of Income**

3. All the proper costs, charges, and expenses of and incidental to the administration and management of the Foundation, shall be first defrayed by the Trustees out of the income thereof.
4. Subject to the payments aforesaid, the net yearly income of the Foundation shall be applied by the Trustees in the manner and to the objects hereinafter prescribed.

### **Special Benefits for Maintained Schools**

5. The Trustees may apply such yearly sum as they think fit, being not more than one quarter of the said net income, in providing special benefits not normally provided by the Local Education Authority, for any maintained Primary School at which pupils from the beneficial area are in attendance.

### **Other Educational Benefits**

6. (1) The residue of the said net income of the Foundation shall be applied by the Trustees in one or more of the following ways:-
  - (a) In promoting, or assisting the promotion, in the beneficial area of religious instruction of beneficiaries in accordance with the doctrines of the Church of England by means of a Sunday School, classes for religious instruction, or otherwise;
  - (b) In the award to beneficiaries of Exhibitions, tenable at any secondary school, training college for teachers, university, or other institution of further (including professional and technical) education, approved by the Trustees, to be awarded under rules to be made by the Trustees, including rules as to the value and period of tenure of the Exhibitions,

**and the qualifications and method of ascertainment and selection, of beneficiaries;**

- (c) In providing financial assistance, outfits, clothing, tools, instruments or books to enable beneficiaries on leaving school, university or any other educational establishment, to prepare for, or to assist their entry into, a profession, trade or calling;**
  - (d) In the grant of financial assistance to any institution of further education, including recreation and social and physical training, not provided by the Local Education Authority, in, or serving the needs of the beneficial area; and**
  - (e) In otherwise promoting the education, including social and physical training of beneficiaries.**
- (2) In the allocation of benefits, the Trustees shall have regard, amongst other things, to the promotion of education in accordance with the principles of the Church of England.**
- (3) The Trustees shall consider the educational qualifications of candidates for benefit.**
- (4) In this clause the expression 'beneficiaries' means persons of either sex born or resident in the beneficial area who have not attained the age of 25 years, and who, in the opinion of the Trustees, are in need of financial assistance; and the expression 'beneficial area' where used in this Scheme means the area comprising the Ecclesiastical Parish of Thornton-Le-Moors with Ince and Elton.**

## **Surplus Income**

- 7. (1) Any income of the Foundation not applied by the Trustees in any year may be retained by them for application in the following year in the manner and to the objects above prescribed.**
- (2) Subject thereto, any sum of cash at any time belonging to the Foundation and not needed as a balance for working purposes shall (unless otherwise directed by the Charity Commissioners) be treated as capital and thereby be invested.**
